The Health Psychology Training Program offers a unique opportunity for fellows to train throughout the Endeavor Health System in primary care offices and specialty outpatient clinics including the Integrated Pain Clinic and Endeavor Health Weight Management. There are also inpatient opportunities through consultation liaison and rehabilitation work. Remote training opportunities on select days also exist. The program uses a health psychology model to provide assessment, treatment planning, and brief, solution-focused models of treatment for a diverse patient population of both developmentally (childhood, adolescents, adults, and elderly) and ethnically and culturally diverse populations.

The Fellow will provide comprehensive services for adult and/or pediatric medical patients with special emphasis on psychosocial oncology, pain management, managing affective disorders in medically ill patients, bariatric procedures, and enhancing treatment compliance. Training includes inpatient interventions and outpatient services, with instruction in a variety of techniques and psychotherapy modalities. The fellow is also expected to participate in departmental teaching and research activities.

Additionally, there are opportunities for presurgical psychological testing of pain and weight loss patients. The fellow will be provided with opportunities to collaborate with treatment teams in either formal meetings or informally and will conceptualize their cases with the interdisciplinary treatment team(s) consisting of primary care doctors, specialists, psychiatrists, psychologists, licensed social workers, and nurses.
